ORDINANCE NO. 0-110-1997

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FARRELL, MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CITY OF FARRELL ORDINANCE NO. 236, DEFINING GARBAGE, PROVIDING FOR ITS COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL, PROHIBITING THE ACCUMULATION THEREOF, PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF FEES AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

THE CITY OF FARRELL ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. DEFINITIONS:

The Section "Definitions" is hereby amended by adding the following:

(f) "Owner or Owners" shall include any legal or equitable owner of real estate upon which is situate, any commercial or single family or multiple family residential structure.

(g) "User" shall mean any person or owner subject to any collection and disposal requirements now or hereafter ordained.

SECTION II. Added to Ordinance No. 236 is the following Section 7 A "Preparation of Rubbish and Garbage" as follows:

(a) Owner shall be responsible for the purchase of receptacles or bags as the case may be for collection and shall provide same to any occupant or occupants obligated to participate in any refuse collection and disposal service.

(b) All refuse collection and disposal service billing statements, the first billing cycle following the effective date of this ordinance, will be directed to the owner of the property being served.

SECTION III. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances insofar as they are inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV. If any section, sentence or other part of this Ordinance is invalid, that which remains is self-sustaining and capable of separate enforcement without regard to the stricken portion.

SECTION V. This Ordinance shall take effect after passage on second and final reading and advertisement thereof in accordance with the Home Rule Charter of the City of Farrell and other applicable law.
